

**Pre-School Programs**



Half-day pre-school programs are available at sites throughout the county for children ages 3-5 (minimum age of 3 by Aug. 31, 2011). Pre-School operates in conjunction with the Prince George's County Public Schools' calendar. When county schools are closed for full days, Pre-School is also closed. Children will participate in age appropriate activities and must be toilet

trained (unless the child has a qualified disability). Fees vary according to the number of days in the program. You may pay in full or schedule 10 monthly payments. Completed health forms are mandatory for participation in this program. Registration begins June 4, 2011. Please call the facility for information about a specific program.

**Morning Care Programs**

This licensed, child care program operates at select sites for the school year for children ages 5-12. Morning Care operates in conjunction with the Prince George's County Public Schools' calendar; both begin in August and end in June. When county schools are closed for full days, Morning Care is also closed. Prince George's county residents enrolled in grades K-6 who are between the ages of 5 and 12 (minimum age of 5 by August 31, 2011) are eligible to enroll in this program. The fee of \$830 may be paid in 10 monthly installments of \$83, plus a \$10 mandatory, non-refundable registration fee, payable in the first installment. Completed health forms are mandatory for participation in this program. Registration begins June 4, 2011. For information about a specific program, please call the facility.

**Kids' Club at Fairland**

Children will participate in tennis, gymnastics, and swimming instruction as well as arts and crafts, games, and sports. Each day time will be set aside for homework and tutoring. This program is for children in grades K-6 with bus transportation (provided by PGCPSS) from Bond Mill Elementary School in Laurel. Children must meet the minimum age by August 31, 2011. Kids' Club operates in conjunction with the Prince George's County Public Schools' calendar; both begin in August and end in June. When county schools are closed for full days, Kids' Club is also closed. The fees are \$3,000 for residents and \$3600 for non-residents which may be scheduled in 10 monthly installments, plus a mandatory, non-refundable \$25 registration fee. Completed health forms are mandatory for participation in this program. Registration begins June 4, 2011. For information, please call:

**Kids' Care After-School Programs**

Kids' Care After-School Programs are licensed, child care programs held at M-NCPPC sites throughout Prince George's County. These programs provide after-school structured recreation activities in the areas of sports, arts and crafts, reading, storytelling, music, film, drama, science, nature, and special events, as well as free, unstructured time for recreational pursuits. Prince George's county residents enrolled in grades K-6 who are between the ages of 5 and 12 (minimum age of 5 by August 31, 2011) are eligible to enroll in this program. Kids' Care operates in conjunction with the Prince George's County Public Schools' calendar; both begin in August and end in June. When county schools are closed for full days, Kids' Care is also closed. The fee of \$1700 may be paid in 10 monthly installments of \$170, plus a \$25 mandatory, non-refundable registration fee, payable in the first installment. Completed health forms are mandatory for participation in this program. Registration begins June 4, 2011. For information about a specific program, please call the facility.

**Therapeutic Recreation Kids' Care After-School and Leisure and Life Skills for Teens Programs**



Open to Prince George's County residents only who are currently enrolled in school and receive Special Education services, Therapeutic Recreation Kids' Care After-School Programs and Leisure and Life Skills programs are also offered by M-NCPPC at sites throughout the county. Kids' Care programs serve the needs of individuals with disabilities who are between the ages of 5 and 21. These specialized programs feature small group sizes, high staff/participant ratios, adapted equipment and more.

Leisure and Life Skills for Teens is an after-school program youth ages 13-21 with developmental disabilities who attend CRI classes at local middle or high schools. This licensed program focuses on social and recreation skill development with opportunities for community integration and socialization with youth without disabilities.

Both programs operate in conjunction with the Prince George's County Public Schools' calendar; both begin in August and end in June. When county schools are closed for full days, Therapeutic Recreation After-School Programs are also closed. The fee of \$1,700 may be paid in 10 monthly installments of \$170, plus a \$25 mandatory registration fee. For those who opt to schedule ten (10) payments, the first payment of \$195 includes the \$25 registration fee, and the subsequent nine (9) payments are \$170 each. Completed health forms are mandatory for participation in this program. Registration begins June 4, 2011. ### Fee Assistance

Participants' inability to pay for M-NCPPC programs does not exclude participation. A fee assistance program is available based on income. Formal proof of need is required. For information, or to receive an application, contact the program site of interest for further details. Fee assistance paperwork must be completed and approved before fee assistance is applied to payments.

### Registration & Health Forms

Maryland state law requires that each child have a complete set of health forms **before** participation in a child care program. It is your responsibility to deliver all necessary health forms to the site at least one week prior to the start of the program. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Your child's registration process is complete when all the forms are received at the program site and fees are paid through the SMARTlink registration system. For therapeutic recreation program sites, return forms to the Special Programs Division, 7833 Walker Drive, #110, Greenbelt, MD 20770.

### SMARTlink Registration Information

SMARTlink is the name of the system used for Internet, telephone, and in-person registration. You must establish a **FREE** SMARTlink account before you can register. Stop by any staffed M-NCPPC facility in Prince George's County and bring appropriate proof of residency (driver's license, MVA card, utility bill, lease agreement or property settlement sheet), identification (driver's license, MVA card, passport, resident/alien card, school ID card, military ID card, or other government-issued ID), and age (driver's license, MVA card, assport, resident/alien card, birth certificate with raised seal, baptismal certificate with birth date and raised seal, or an original letter from school on official stationery) for each member of your immediate family. You'll receive a family Personal Identification Number (PIN) and Client Barcode that will allow you to register by phone, Internet, mail, or in person. M-NCPPC uses the latest in payment security. Collection and retention of customer information is confidential. We do not give, share, sell, transfer, or rent any personal information to third parties.

### Before you register, have the following ready...

- Client Barcode and Family PIN
- Program information
- VISA credit/debit card or MasterCard credit/debit card number and expiration date
- Registration begins at 9 am on June 4.

### To register by phone

Touch-tone telephone registration is available 24 hours a day. Call 301-583-BOOK (2665) and follow the prompts.

### To register via the Internet

### To register in person

Drop by any staffed Department of Parks and Recreation facility during regular business hours. Our friendly staff will take your registration and payment.

### Returned Check Policy

Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 fee by M-NCPPC, in addition to your bank charges.

### Transportation

M-NCPPC does not provide transportation to and from sites. Children may be able to get from school to Kids' Care sites on school buses provided by your child's school. Contact your school directly.
