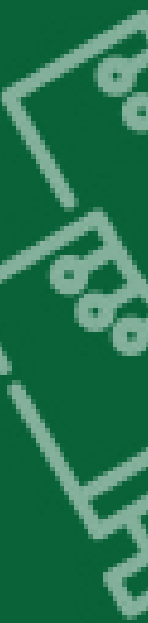
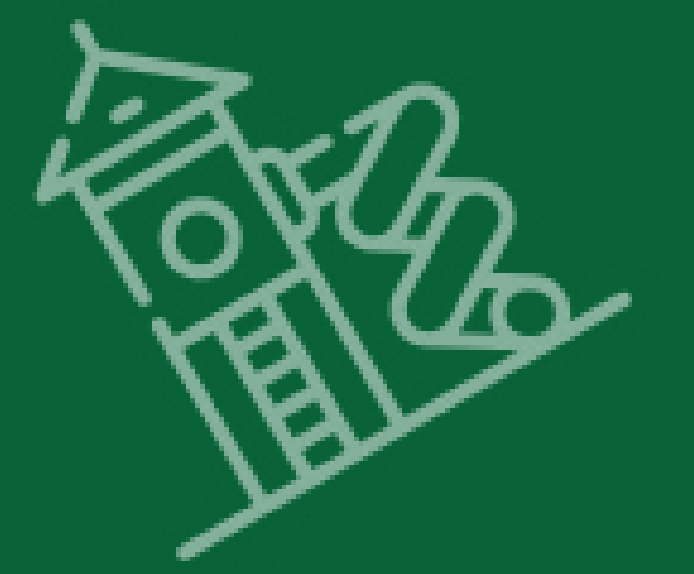
Playground Renovation Plan

- Comfort facilities such as seating, shade, and water filling stations
- Maintenance considerations for a high traffic playground
