#1 HIKE @ JAMES and ANNE ROBINSON NATURE CENTER HOWARD COUNTY

6692 Cedar Lane, Columbia, MD 21044

SIGN LOCATION: Left of Entrance @ Sycamore Stroll Trail and Mill Ruins Trail Signs

Enjoy a hike on a .6 mile trail to the Simpsonville Mill Historical Ruins situated alongside the Middle Patuxent River. Hours of operation are Wed. thru Sat., 9:00AM to 5:00PM; Sunday, noon to 5:00PM. Admission is \$5.00 for Adults and \$3.00 for Children 3-17 yrs., under 3 free. Admission fee includes access to our LEED Platinum Nature Center's 2 stories of exhibits, Children's Discovery room and, "NaturePlace", a children's outdoor nature discovery area. 410-313-0400

Bring your favorite picnic and enjoy a scenic view of the T. Howard Duckett Reservoir, the drinking water source for 1/3 of WSSC's customers. A WSSC watershed <u>use permit is</u> required. Area is closed from December 1st until about March

#4 HIKE @ SUPPLEE RECREATION AREA MONTGOMERY COUNTY

Park at 16904 Supplee Lane, Laurel, MD 20707

SIGN LOCATION: County line

Hike or horseback ride (need own horse) North on the multiuse trail to the line for Prince George's and Montgomery County (2 miles roundtrip). On the way back, explore the shoreline or grab your fishing gear or binoculars to look for eagles and great blue herons.

A WSSC watershed use permit is required to hike and a valid State of Maryland fishing license if you plan to fish. Area is closed from December 1st until about March 15th. Call 301-206-4FUN to check hours.

#5 HIKE @ RIVERFRONT PARK CITY OF LAUREL

Avondale Street, Laurel, MD 20707

SIGN LOCATION: Trail Head

Enjoy a hike through scenic wetlands and historic dam ruins on the 1.5 mile paved trail at Riverfront Park. This park is also located next to the Laurel Museum. There is no admission fee. Park is open seven days a week; dawn to dusk.

#6 HIKE @ GOVERNOR BRIDGE NATURAL AREA PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: Red Trail

Enjoy a 0.75 mile hike through wildflowers and mature hardwood forest to a scenic overlook of the Patuxent River. There is no admission fee. Park is open daily from <u>8:00am</u> to dusk. 301-627-6074

#7 FISHING @ PATUXENT WETLANDS PARK ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: Fishing Pier

Cast your line from the Patuxent Wetlands Park fishing pier to catch the big one. Common species include blue and channel catfish, white and yellow perch, northern snakehead, and largemouth bass. Persons 16 or older are required to have a valid Maryland Chesapeake Bay & Coastal Sport Fishing License. No admissions fee. Park is open dawn to dusk. #8 HIKE @ GLENDENING NATURE PRESERVE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

1290 Wrighton Road, Lothian, MD 20711

SIGN LOCATION: Chris Swarth Boardwalk off Cliff Trail

Experience the marsh up close with a 0.6 mile hike along a forested bluff to the Chris Swarth Boardwalk. No admissions fee. Parking and trail maps are located at the Wrighton Road entrance of the Glendening Preserve; open daily from 9:00am-5:00pm. Reservations are not required.

#9 PADDLE @ JUG BAY NATURAL AREA PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

16000 Croom Airport Road, Upper Marlboro, MD 20772 SIGN LOCATION: Canoe Launch @ Jackson's Landing

Rent (or bring your own) canoe or kayak to explore the freshwater tidal marshes of the Patuxent River by water. Daily canoe/kayak rentals are available April through October. There is no admission fee. Park is open daily 8am to dusk. 301-627-6074

#10 PADDLE @ KINGS LANDING PARK CALVERT COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: Fishing Pier

Bring your own canoe, kayak, or standup paddleboard to explore the middle Patuxent and this brackish water estuary. Canoe/kayak/paddleboard rentals may be available in 2018, call for more information. There is no admission fee. Park is open daily 9:00AM to 8:00PM Memorial Day to Labor Day; 9:00AM to 5:00PM Labor Day to Memorial Day. 410-535-2661

#11 HIKE @ MAXWELL HALL PARK CHARLES COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: Beach Rest Area off Blue Trail

Hike the 2.8 mile Blue Trail loop through fields and forests to the peaceful beach rest area. Pack a picnic lunch and enjoy the scenic view of the Patuxent River. Park is open daily 8:00am to dusk. 301-932-3470

#12 HIKE @ JEFFERSON PATTERSON PARK AND MUSEUM CALVERT COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: Along Village Trail

This ADA-accessible trail begins across from the Pavilion and takes visitors to the replica Indian Village. Along the way, interpretive signs talk about the changes in the environment and landscape in the past 400 years, as well as the Eastern Woodland Indian culture of past, present, and future. #13 HIKE @ HISTORIC SOTTERLEY PLANTATION ST. MARY'S COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: At the Visitors Center

Whether you come by car or boat, experience 300 years of history at Sotterley, with 94 acres, over 20 historic buildings including a 1703 Plantation House and 1830's Slave Cabin, Colonial Revival Gardens and more. Guest can hike almost 6 miles on Sotterley's trail system, to include overlooks of Sotterley Creek and the Patuxent River. The Visitor Center is open May 1 – Oct. 31 for the Guided Tour season: Tues. – Sat. from 10:00AM – 4:00AM and Sunday from Noon – 4:00AM. The site is open year round for self-guided tours, and guests still begin their visit at the Visitor Center. Fees for ages 6 and up range from \$5.00 to \$10.00, and full information about visiting and fees can be found online. 301-373-2280

#14 WALK, WADE, BEACH-COMB @ MYRTLE POINT PARK ST MARY'S COUNTY

SIGN LOCATION: Along Wet Sox Trail

This 0.5 mile beach trail begins at the picnic area and offers beautiful vistas of the Solomon's Bridge and access to the park's beach and favorite fishing spots. Continue through the woods past the beach to return to the main parking area along a rolling grassy lane.

Fee when gates are open: County resident \$5.00 per vehicle, Out of County resident \$10.00 per vehicle. Park is open daily from sunrise to sunset (except for special evening and night activities).
