What is Service Learing!

Service-Learning is a teaching method that combines meaningful service to the community with curriculumbased learning. Students improve their academic skills by applying what they learn in school to the real world; they then reflect on their experience to reinforce the link between their service and their learning.



Why Service Learning!

SSL IN PECPS

Per Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) All students must earn a total of 75 hours in order to earn a high school diplomia.

- Required number of hours: 75
- Infused hours: 54
- Independent hours: 24

INDEPENDENT HOURS

Students may begin earning hours after completing 5th grade!



Middle School Students

Effective SY 2022-2023
Middle School students are required required to earn 8 hours of Service Learning Hours



Dear Ms. Goldson.

Do you know what body dysmorphia disorder is? BDD, for short, is when a person is extremely insecure about their appearance. Victims constantly criticize their bodies, seek reassurance, and try to change their appearance; to the point where they develop other mental disorders like depression or anxiety. Around 4.8% of teenagers suffer from BDD. Now, while that may seem like a low amount, most teens who have this disorder don't get diagnosed and often suffer in silence. A combination of BDD and depression is part of the reason why 1 in 6 Maryland teens consider suicide. I have prompt two solutions to this issue:

- Mental health tip jars: A jar in the school counselors' office where students can express themselves without judgment.
- Promote professional help: Provide students with information about certified behavioral therapy or psychotherapy centers.

BDD is often misunderstood as having low-self esteem, or a normal stage of puberty. This disorder, Ms. Goldson, exceeds low-self esteem, people with this disorder sometimes imagine body imperfections. As stated earlier, BDD can lead to more serious mental disorders like social anxiety. My solutions will give students easy and accessible ways to receive help. Body dysmorphic disorder has no cure, but there are resources out there to prevent those who suffer from feeling completely helpless.



Steps for Earning Independent Hours

FIRST: (PREPARATION) Consider what activity you want to do or what specific organization you want to work with.

SSL activities can be done with nonprofit, for-profit, tax-exempt, private, and faith-based organizations/facilities.

SSL and Church Activities

Per MSDE students may not gain hours in any activity that is religious in nature. Community outreach events that the church may sponser (i.e food pantry, afterschool tutoring) are permissible.

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NEXT: (ACTION) If the organization and activities are:

Pre-Approved

- Contact the organization and volunteer to serve.
- Participate in the SSL activity.

Not Pre-Approved

- Complete a Service Learning Site Approval Form and submit it to your SSL Coordinator for approval PRIOR TO BEGINNING service.
- Upon receiving approval from the SSL Coordinator, participate in the SSL activity

Next: (REFLECTION) Complete a SSL Verification Form to document service performed in the summer or within each semester service is done.


Last: Turn completed Verification Form into School-Based Service-Learning Coordinator by September 30 for summer service or by the end of each semester in which service is done for SSL hours to be reflected in SchoolMAX or on your official transcript.
