
The Battle of Bladensburg Boat Tours




White Tail Deer

(Odocoileus virginianus)

Our trail camera spotted a beautiful white tail deer near the Anacostia River Trail in early Spring.

Female deer, known as does, give birth to fawns in May and June. The young fawns are left alone in the forest, hidden for a few weeks while the mother returns to nurse them multiple times a day. This behavior is to avoid attracting predators, so it's crucial for people not to approach the young deer. They are not lost.


