Dear Adult Social Club Members and parents/caregivers,

We are pleased to introduce our 2026 Adult Social Club Programs, designed to support adults with developmental disabilities by providing safe, structured, and engaging social opportunities within the community. These programs focus on building friendships, encouraging independence, exploring new interests, and maintaining an active lifestyle. Clubs meet twice a month at various locations throughout the county and are fully facilitated and supervised by our trained and experienced staff.

In response to increased interest and program demand, we are expanding from five to six clubs in 2026 to ensure continued quality programming and appropriate staff support for all participants.

The membership fee for joining an Adult Social Club is \$70. Once you register, you will receive a monthly newsletter **emailed** between the 12th and 15th of each month. Feel free to sign up for activities that align with your interests; please note that some events may incur an additional fee of \$5 or more, depending on the specific activity. All Social Club events are typically held on Fridays and Saturdays, while the Performing Arts Club gathers on Sundays.

Please note that Adult Social Club Registration Forms will only be accepted during the open enrollment window of January 2 - March 31, 2026. Registration forms received after that date will be referred to the 2026 Social Clubs. Spaces are limited per club, and they fill quickly. Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

To register for the Adult Social Clubs:

- 1) Complete your **2026 Adult Social Club Registration Form** and return it to us, via mail or email within the open enrollment window. Participants must follow the Social Club Guidelines to maintain their membership.
- 2) Place a **credit on your Parks Direct account** for the registration fee of **\$70. (Please reference page 4.)**
- 3) You will be notified via email and mail when your Club Membership has been processed. (*If your registration form is missing information or is incomplete, your registration may be returned and not processed.*)

Club meeting locations are indicated in the attached chart (**page 3**). To add a credit to your Parks Direct account, follow the step-by-step guidelines provided (**page 4**).


